

SCHOOL BOARD ORDERS SPECIAL ELECTION HELD

**MORE MONEY MUST BE RAISED
IN EXCESS OF LEVY TO MAIN-
TAIN BINFORD SCHOOL FOR
COMING TERM.**

The Board of Education is face to face with a dilemma that threatens the progress of our school, and the only possible relief in sight, is in the calling of a special election. This the Board has decided to do, and official announcement is printed elsewhere in today's Times.

Conservative estimates of the cost of maintaining the school for the coming term is placed at \$8,000. Total expenditures for last term is in excess of available receipts and there is a possibility of the state holding up the apportionment fund due the district this year, which, if it occurs only adds to the burden.

To relieve the situation somewhat there was no other alternative than a special election, authorizing a 25 per cent increase in excess of one third of the combined levies of 1918, 1919, and 1920, plus the 30 per cent. This will bring the receipts to approximately \$7,000.

The election is called for Tuesday, August 2, between the hours of 2:00 and 5:00 p. m.
