

TEACHERS ARE SECURED FOR SCHOOL TERM

**BINFORD SCHOOL WILL OPEN
TERM ON SEPTEMBER 12—
TWO NEW TEACHERS—LAB-
ORATORY INSTALLED**

Only two more weeks of the glorious period remains and then those young Americans in this community between the ages of six and twenty years must again wend their way schoolward. Such is the announcement of the school officers.

The local school will open this year on Monday, September 12. Everything is being lined up to start the school machine to moving on the first day. The board of education has secured a corp of teachers this year which, it is believed, will prove to be one of the most competent ever engaged in work here. Two of last year's faculty, Miss Margaret Shelp, principal, and Frank H. Bixby, grammar department, will return. The two new members are Miss Ingrid Formoe, of Elbow Lake, Minnesota, who will have charge of the intermediate department, and Miss Esther Otteson, Cooperstown, the primary grades.

The congested condition of the school is giving the board no little concern, but everything possible will be done to relieve this difficulty, so as not to interfere with the school work, and to permit of extra studies. A new laboratory is to be one of the new additions and it likely that this will have to be placed in the basement.

The prospects are bright for a successful term.
