

## G. & F. WINS

With Spooner pitching a superb brand of base ball and his team mates on the infield according him almost faultless support, the G. & F. won the second of the Inter-League classic, at Sutton last evening, by a 6-2 count.

Spooner had the Home Players completely at his mercy, after getting away to a bad start in the first inning, when they collected their two runs. In fact, Spooner was so effective that he kept all the defensive play confined strictly to the infield—the outfield having no chances.

Tucker, first up in the first inning drew a walk. Liesman got on thru Spooner's error, when he threw wild to first, both runners advancing a base. Wickham hit over second, scoring Tucker and Liesman. Wick was caught stealing second. Hafner and Melgard struck out, and from then on during the entire session only five men got on the paths and just once were they in threatening distance to home base. Three lone hits were allowed by Spooner. He passed two, hit one and struck out twelve.

The G. & F. evened the count in the first inning. Metz hit safe, but was forced out at second on Nelson's roller. Peterson followed with a smash to center sending Nelson home. On the play to the plate, Peterson took third and scored on Leahy's single.

Peterson, of Rogers, was pitching for the Home Players, and worked four innings, when Ronning of Clementsville, took on the task.

In the sixth, after Metz retired on a pop fly to Wickham, Nelson hit a sharp one to Tucker, at third, which went for a hit. Peterson was given life when Melgard dropped his easy fly. Slyter forced Peterson at second, for the second out. The fusillade then started. Leahy hit a terrific smash over left for three bases, scoring Nelson and Slyter. Ehlers scored Leahy, and Johnson drove Ehlers home with a two-ply blow. Fosberg ended the inning. Four runs.

This win by the G. & F. players ties up the series. The deciding game will be played at Sutton on Sunday, August 6.
