

Commissioners Pass Resolution

Resolution of the Board of County Commissioners adopted at the meeting held the 8th day of February, 1922.

WHEREAS, a request has been made by the Governor of this State that economy be practiced in the management of affairs of the State and its subdivisions, wherever possible;

Therefore, Be it resolved: By the Board of County Commissioners of Griggs County; that we practice economy in every way possible in order to reduce taxation on the people of this County, and

Be it further Resolved: We do hereby ask of each and every school officer, also all city and village officials to co-operate with us in the practice of economy where the same is possible and consistent with the proper administration of public affairs, and that a copy of this resolution be sent to the Governor of this State and to each of the newspapers of the county for one publication in each and to all County, City, Village, Township and School District Officials.
