Commenced business on May 15, 1917. On Dec. 31st of the same year the company had written \$122,825.00 worth of insurance. During the year 1918 the company wrote \$111,145.00. During the year 1919 the company wrote \$234,970.00 worth of insurance and in the year 1920 the company did better than in either of the preceding years by writing \$397,549.00, making a grand total of \$866,489.00. The company has \$5,271.25 in the bank drawing 6 per cent interest. They also have farmers notes to the amount of \$977.51 drawing 7 per cent interest. The losses of the company for the four years of business is \$780.
