It is gratifying to the editor to see that a number of good Nonpartisans in the district where the "petition" was circulated, refused to become a party to this underhanded attempt to intimidate this newspaper and did not sign the "petition."

This is the first organized attempt that has come to our attention from any part of the state to carry out Mr. Townley's "big threat" last fall when going the final rounds before election to see that all business men in the towns who did not subscribe to his political beliefs were helped to get out of business.
