

TWO CASES INFANTILE PARALYSIS IN COUNTY

Two cases of infantile paralysis have developed in Griggs county during the past two weeks. One of the two cases resulted in the death of Charles Rice, the four-year-old son of a family living on one of the Huso farms in Lenora township. The child died last Friday.

The second case is that being suffered by Evelyn Houghton, eight-year old daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Walter Houghton. While the little girl is very seriously ill, her recovery is expected.

Health authorities of the county have taken every precaution to head off the possible spread of the disease. There are said to be cases of it in Nelson county in the Aneta neighborhood, and considerable of the disease in Minot.

It is believed that a serious spread of the disease will perhaps be avoided because of the lateness of the season. Had the trouble shown up early in August the consequences might have been far more serious than they are now at this late day.
