
"DOCTOR" KIRBY WILL

BUILD "HOSPITAL"

Samuel R. Kirby, who attained considerable fame as a "healer" and brought thousands of people from all parts of the United States and Canada during his practice at Thief River Falls, Minnesota, and Northwood, has decided to return to Thief River Falls from Northwood, where he moved last fall.

Kirby visited Thief River Falls last week and arranged for the construction of a "hospital" or "sanatorium" which will house his patients. The building, about 25x60, will be one-story and stuccoed. It will be erected on the Kirby farm near the city and work will be rushed in order to complete the structure by November 1, at which time Kirby will return there. He will also maintain a downtown office. Recently workmen have built porches and made other improvements about the Kirby residence, which was the Mecca for thousands of ailing people up to the time of his removal last fall.
