

Kolstad Is Appointed Postmaster in Cooper

Official advices from Washington early in the week, state that Hans J. Kolstad has been appointed postmaster at Cooperstown, to succeed V. F. Nelson.

There were six applicants for the position. All but three were eliminated by the civil service examination and the probable selection from among those who were still in the race at the finish, caused a lively interest in Cooperstown, and even beyond the confines of the city.

Mr. Nelson has made a splendid record as an accommodating and efficient postmaster and there are many who desired that he receive a reappointment. However, the selection of Mr. Kolstad is not in the least unpopular.
