

MAIL SERVICE EXTENDED TO RED WILLOW LAKE

Postmaster Peterson has succeeded in securing the extension of mail service to Red Willow Lake, commencing July 1, and continuing until September 1. Rural Carrier Krogness will supply this service to lake patrons.

It has been suggested to the post office department to erect a collection box at the lake for the receipt of mail for those who are not regular residents there during the summer season, but this additional accommodation has not yet been approved.

Lake residents are requested to erect their mail boxes in a group at a point just north of the grade at the east end of the lake and placed so that it will enable the carrier to conveniently make a turn.

This extension of mail facilities should prove popular and it is to be hoped that the patronage will be such as to warrant its continuance each season. That, however, depends upon those for whom it was established. Should it appear to be a losing proposition, it is doubtful if service will be resumed next season.
