

MOGAARD BARN BURNED

The splendid barn on the farm of County Commissioner Melal Mogaard was completely destroyed by fire early Saturday morning about 3:30 o'clock. The origin of the fire is unknown, and when discovered had gained such headway that it was impossible to save the building. Fortunately nearly all the stock was in the pasture, and no loss of livestock was sustained. There was a large quantity of hay in the barn, and the barn was equipped with many labor saving devices and conveniences so the property destroyed was very valuable.

We understand the loss is fully covered by insurance.

LATER. It is reported that the metal parts of a suit case, a file, pliers and other small tools, have been found in the ashes, and this naturally indicates that some one beating their way along the G. N. had got off at Revere, and sought the barn as a place to spend the night. If this is the case, it is a question whether the man escaped or was cremated in the flames.—Hannaford Enterprise.
