

Large Fleet of Boats for Lake

The Red Willow Lake Park association has closed a deal with J. L. Moore for the row boat and launch concession at the lake for the 1921 season. A committee representing the directors, and Mr. Moore, were at the lake last week and have agreed on a location to erect the docks.

The sale of this important concession will meet with instant approval, and, inasmuch as Mr. Moore owns the largest and best boat outfit in the state it will make an attraction for Lake Willow that compares favorably with the larger lake resorts in Minnesota. He has 18 row boats and one 26-foot Brooks launch.

Mr. Moore has been operating these boats at Spiritwood lake, but since he moved to Binford, he feels that he can devote more of his personal attention to them if placed at Red Willow. The job of transferring them was commenced yesterday, by truck.

With Mr. Moore's boats, and the four rowboats and one launch owned by the association, which are included in the concession, there should be adequate accommodation in this respect for some time to come.

The boats will be given a coat of white paint and otherwise overhauled before being placed on the water.
