## **SHERIFF AT DANCES NOW**

The county sheriff or a deputy is required to be present after July 1 at every dance given in the county, outside of an incorporated city or village, where those who attend pay for that privilege, according to a law to that effect passed by the last legislature. In order that this may be done, the proprietor or manager is expected to announce to the sheriff's office each dance that falls within the above class and may be held liable for not doing so, it is said.

The new state law also forbids Sunday dances and says that the proprietor or manager of a dance hall who permits persons under 18 years of age to enter the place without their parents or guardians may be prosecuted. This section of the law also goes into effect on July 1st.
