
NEW BOUNTY ON WOLF

PELTS EFFECTIVE IN MAY

The new state wolf bounty law as passed by the North Dakota legislature during the recent session, goes into effect on May 1, according to P. A. Melgard, county auditor. Under the provisions of the new law, state bounty of \$5 for each grown wolf or coyote, and \$2 for each pup killed before September 1 of each year will be paid. The old law provides a bounty of \$2.50 for each wolf or coyote, regardless of age.
