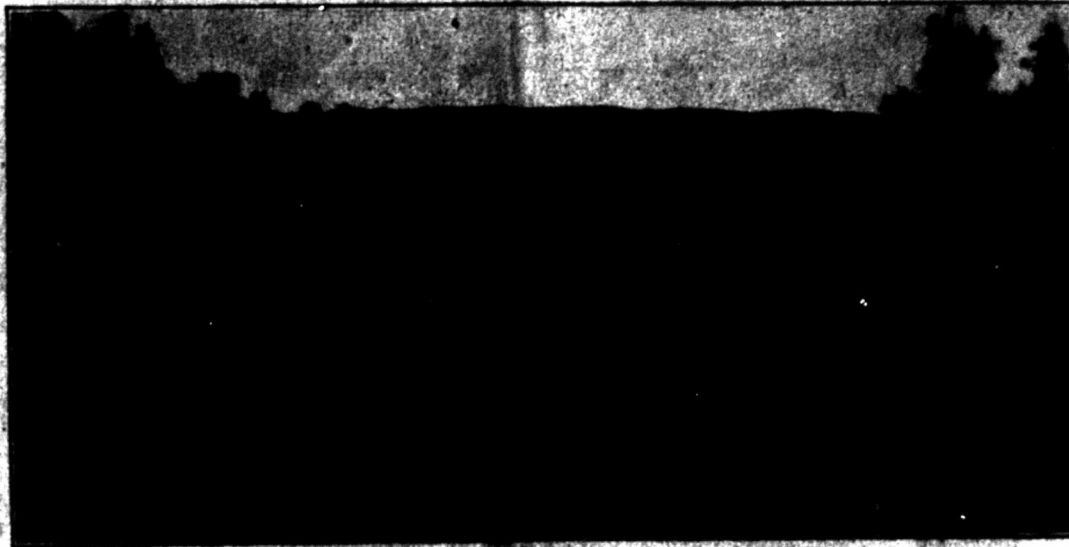


# Picturesque Lake Resort Will Be the Scene of Monster Celebration.
