**AVIATOR FLADELAND AND DARE
EVIL BLACKSTONE WILL PER-
FORM AERIAL STUNTS AT RED
WILLOW LAKE—BALL GAME**

Red Willow Lake enthusiasts and baseball fans will be treated to something extraordinary at an Aerial Frolic and baseball game to be staged at three o'clock, Sunday afternoon, August 14, at Red Willow lake.

J. Earl Fladeland, well known Northwest aviator and Al Blackstone foremost daredevil wing walker and parachute jumper of this country will stage and act, including walking erect on edge of upper wings, standing in center of plane on top during loop with no stirrups or handholds, swinging acrobatics from rope ladder far beneath plane, and the parachute jump from the plane into the lake, done so near the crowd that all can plainly see the jump-off.

The baseball game promises much excitement, the aerial acts have excellent letters of recommendation from most of the best fairs of the state, the boating, bathing and fishing are the finest in eastern North Dakota. The woods never were more inviting, consequently if the day is good several thousand people are expected to turn out. In case of rain the program will be postponed until the following Sunday.
