

PAVILION SITE AT THE LAKE IS SELECTED

STOCKHOLDERS MEET IN ANNUAL SESSION—DIRECTORS AND OFFICERS CHOSEN—PAVILION PLANS ARE MADE.

The annual stockholders meeting of the Red Lake Park Association was held last Friday, when the following directors were elected for the ensuing year: H. F. Cole, E. E. Iverson, M. D. Leininger, Oscar Greenland, E. F. Ringlee, A. J. Anderson, Matt Rorvig, Robert Thorn, H. A. Brown, George Knauss, Otto Pritz.

The new board organized with Otto Pritz a president, H. A. Brown, vice president, and Oscar Greenland, secretary-treasurer.

Bids were received for material and labor in the construction of the pavilion, and all were rejected. This does not mean, however, that plans for the building have been abandoned. The finances of the association are such that it is impractical to attempt at this time, the completion of the building for this season, but a start is to be made. The directors decided to lay the foundation and floor and have engaged masons to begin work the latter part of this week. Operations will be pushed with all possible haste and it is expected to have the floor completed by the middle of June.

The directors were on the ground Monday to select a site for the pavilion. The original location submitted in the plans of the landscape engineer last fall did not meet with the board's approval because of the many fine, large trees which would have to be removed. After going over the grounds thoroughly and considering the matter from every angle, a place on the west side of the old base ball park was chosen. The building, located there, will afford ample seating room for those who wish to witness the various sports that will be held in that open space.

Thursday, June 2, has been designated by the board as a general improvement day. At this time it is expected that all who can will devote their time to assist in beautifying the grounds, cutting brush, making roads and otherwise making themselves useful. Those who have teams that are not in use are requested to bring them, and all should bring a shovel. The association has arranged to feed the bunch.
