VERDICT FAVORS ROSE; BOISJOLIE TO APPEAL Sentinel-Courier: Justice Nels P. Nelson awarded verdict Thursday in favor of Dr. F. W. Rose, who was plaintiff in an action brought to remove a renter, L. J. Boisjolie, from the farm owned by Rose, just south of Cooperstown. While the court found for the plaintiff, the damages demanded were not awarded, the court order merely ordering Boisjolie t from the farm. Attorney Sad represented the plaintiff and Attorney Paulson of Valley City appeared for the defendant. An appeal is being taken by the defendant and his attor-8 nev. The case has been of interest localb ly. The owner of the farm had this fall engaged a new renter for his farm. When the renter sought to įŧ move onto the place Mr. Boisjolie refused to leave, asserting he had a right to remain another year. The appeal of the case will make it possible for Boisjolie to remain on the farm until spring at least.
