Miss Saby is said to have obtained the poison through the use of a prescription which was for external use only and swallowed it in a fit of despondency. Just what kind of poison she drank could not be determined but it was thought to be bichloride. She has recovered sufficiently to leave her bed and the attending physician said that she may probably leave the hospital in a short time. Miss Saby, an employe of the hotel, drank the poison in sight of several people in the lobby. A physician was called and administered antidotes before ordering the girl brought to a hospital.
