

FARMERS TO BUILD

MODERN ELEVATOR

Underwood Times: S. A. Pritz, manager of the Farmers Elevator & Mercantile company in this city, announces that the contract for the erection of a new building on the site of the one which burned in February, has been let to the L. Burgess Construction company of Minneapolis.

The capacity of this elevator will be 40,000 bushels, with the bins all hopper bottom. The equipment is to be modern in every respect. A ten-ton scale will be provided, with a truck dump; an automatic shipping scale will also be one of the up-to-date features of the new house.

In fact, this new elevator is to be one of the most modern and up-to-date grain handling plants in this part of the state. It should indeed be a source of pride to its owners and a credit to Underwood.

Construction work will be started as soon as possible and the plant is to be completed by July 1.
