

ANOTHER FIRE AT WALUM

Hannaford Enterprise: Fire broke out from unknown origin about one a. m. Monday in the rear part of the Crane-Johnson lumber sheds here, and before it was noticed had gained such headway that it was impossible to save any of the lumber shed and its contents, and only the books and a few small articles were saved from the stock of hardware owned by Campbell Bros. Hardware Co., who occupy a portion of the Crane-Johnson building. A considerable quantity of lubricating oils were in stock and this gave the fire an added strength, several explosions occurring. All the men in town were on hand and with the assistance of the Hannaford fire department managed to check the fire so that a considerable portion of the lumber owned by the Crane-Johnson Co., and which was stored outside in the yard was saved. It is not yet known just what insurance was carried on the building or stock.
