## WALUM FARMER IS SENTENCED

Valley City Times-Record: Arvie Wunderlich was brought before Judge Chas. M. Cooley before the opening of court yesterday morning in the judge's chamber to answer to a charge of the illicit manufacture of intoxicating liquors. He pleaded guilty to the charge and Judge Cooley sentenced him to 3 months in the county jail and to pay a fine of \$200. In the event of nonpayment of the fine the prisoner was sentenced to an additional 50 days in jail. Mr. Wunderlich is a farmer living west of Walum in Griggs county, and was brought before Judge Cooley by States Attorney Sad of Coopers town.
