The death of Mrs. Peter Burns of Ottofy, which occurred on Saturday at five o'clock, has caused a deep gloom to overcast the entire community. Having been a resident of her neighborhood for more than twenty years and having lived a life of usefulness she had greatly endeared herself to the memories of all who knew her and many are the admiring friends who lament her demise.
