

WENT BACK TO NORWAY RICH

O. J. Larson and wife left last Monday for Norway where they expect to reside in the future. Mr. and Mrs. Larson came to this country twenty years ago with nothing and both worked out by the month. They finally got enough money together to buy a yoke of oxen and a plow and began farming on a small scale, gradually working up until they owned a half section of land. Last fall Mr. Larson sold out and when he left last Monday he carried with him a draft for \$10,200 besides plenty of money for his journey. When reduced to Norwegian money this makes 37,950 kroners. A kroner in Norway will buy as much as a dollar will here, so Mr. Larson will be a rich man there, and he made it all in twenty years.
