

PIONEER GONE.

T. K. Rogney Passes Away Tuesday Morning at the Home of His Son.

At the home of his son, Oscar, in Jessie, T. K. Rogney, one of the first settlers in this country, passed away at seven o'clock Tuesday morning, death being due to heart failure.

He had been afflicted with heart trouble off and on all winter, but it was not until a short time before his death that it took on a serious nature.

Deceased was a pioneer resident in this county, coming here from Goodhue county, Minnesota, in 1883, and settling on a homestead one mile and a half from Jessie, where he resided until five years ago, since which time he has made his home with his son, Oscar.

Deceased is survived by four children, Oscar of Jessie, Gilbert of Drake, Marion of Seattle, and Mrs. Otto Beck of New England, this state.

The funeral services will be held at the house in Jessie tomorrow (Friday) forenoon. Interment will be made in the West Prairie church cemetery.
