

New Foster County Bank.

Another new bank has been organized in Foster county, called the First State Bank Glenfield Township, and is located on the townsite of the Great Northern and Dakota Townsite company, on the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 21, township 146, range 62, bringing the new town, which is yet without a name, about a mile east and 8 miles south of McHenry and 25 miles due east of Carrington. The bank is organized with a capital stock of \$10,000, the stockholders being A. H. Berg, Cooperstown, 20 shares; H. P. Hammer, Cooperstown, 15 shares; Geo. E. Berg, Courtney, 20 shares; Jno. O. Oie, Cooperstown, 10 shares; J. H. Berg, Cooperstown, 15 shares; H. S. Halvorson, McHenry, 20 shares. The charter grants the new company a corporate existence of 25 years from the 7th day of May, 1910.--Carrington Record.
