

The railroad meeting at Cooperstown last Saturday was attended by about 200 interested citizens. It was resolved to go ahead and try to secure free-right-of-way for the proposed railroad and a cash bonus as asked by the representatives of the company. F. D. Williams was chosen president, Theo. Thompson secretary of the county committee. Committees as follows were appointed for the townships directly interested: Helna; Jones, Mogaard and Francis; Bald Hill; Soma. Fuglestad and Watne; Bartley; Palm, Evenson and Byington; Mabel; Anderson, Ryington and Howden; Dover; Peterson, Mikelthun and Baum. Several farmers here have promised free right-of-way across their lands. Others will be called upon to contribute ranging from a few cents to one dollar or more an acre according to nearness to the railroad and to the side and away from the same.
