Lyman R. Casey, one of the first members of the first congressional delegation from North Dakota after statehood, being United States senator from 1889 to 1893, died at his home in Washington, D. C., on Monday, of heart failure at the age of 77. Mr. Casey, since disposing of land holdings near Carrington, has resided in Washington and in Baltimore. He was elected while a resident of Jamestown, and he was for about ten years previous to his election, a resident of the state. During the period that Mr. Casey was a North Dakota senator, the republicans were in power.
