

Jonas Enstad Dead

Pekin Budget: On Wednesday the sad news of the death of Jonas Enstad was received in Pekin from St. Paul by wire.

About the last of August Mr. Enstad was on a load of bundles with an oil can in his hand, when the side of the rack gave way throwing him to the ground and running the spout of the can into the side of his head. He was at once taken to the hospital at Northwood, where he remained until about two weeks ago, when he was taken to the St. Lukes hospital in St. Paul, and remained until his death, Wednesday morning.

Mr. Enstad is an old resident of this vicinity, his father having filed on a homestead about five miles south-east of Pekin long before the railroad went through, and has lived there ever since.

Mr. Enstad at the time of his death was 32 years, eight months and twenty days old.

He leaves to mourn his demise a father, Ole Enstad, brother, Carl, two sisters, Mrs. Casper Foreing and Miss Louise Enstad.
