

FOUNDER McVILLE JOURNAL IS DEAD.

**Former McVile Editor Dies in California,
As a Result of Typhoid Fever.**

The sad news of the death of Arnold O. Lang, at Santa Anna, California, was received at McVile last Saturday and it was a severe shock to his many friends and relatives in this section of the state. Deceased was the youngest son of Mr. and Mrs. J. C. Lang, formerly of Hope, Steele county, and a brother of Fred N. Lang, teller of the Hope National bank, and Leo L. Lang, editor of The McVile Journal. He was a young man of bright prospects and but 28 years of age. He edited The Journal at McVile for several months in the infancy of the paper. Typhoid fever was the cause of his death.
