

REV. JENSON RESIGNS.

Accepts Splendid Call From Badger, Iowa.

Rev. J. M. Jenson, who has had charge of the congregations at Cooperstown, Binford, and Ottawa, will tender his resignation soon, and will leave in about three months for Badger, Iowa, where he has accepted a splendid call. This news will cause a feeling of deep regret among his congregations and also among many people who are not identified with his churches. His resignation will be accepted with a great deal of reluctance.

Rev. Jenson took charge of his congregations in this county about five years ago. During that time he has built up a strong church following, and with his influence, and good sound sense, united with strong convictions, and a candid, outspoken temper, he has materially aided in raising a high standard of citizenship in our community. His removal will be a distinct loss.

Badger, where he has accepted the call, is a small town about the size of Binford. It is situated about nine miles from Fort Dodge, Iowa. He will have charge of but one congregation there.

His decision to remove from among us will cause regret, but the best wishes for happiness and prosperity for himself and wife will go with them to their new home.
