

VILLAGE ELECTION WAS VERY QUIET

Caucus Ticket Elected Except for Trustee in the Third Ward and Assessor.

Very little interest was aroused over the village election Tuesday, and with the exception of trustee in the third ward and assessor, the entire caucus ticket was elected with practically no opposition. 37 votes were cast. All the old officers except the assessor and marshal were re-elected.

It was understood by many that Geo. D. Bowe, who was nominated for trustee in the third ward, would not serve in case he was elected. In the contest for this office Aug. Evers received 21 votes and Mr. Bowe 14, with Ole Bakken and F. G. Lewis each receiving one. Albert Alfson's refusal to serve as assessor another year made it necessary to elect another for that position. F. G. Lewis and Martin Rood were the principal contestants, the former winning by a vote of 23 to 10. Albert Alfson and Chas. Patterson each received two votes. A. W. Ringlee, the caucus nominee for marshal, received 29 votes, but it is understood that he will not qualify, so it will fall to the board of trustees to appoint some one to fill the vacancy.
