

Village Primary Election.

A light vote was cast at the primary election yesterday in this village, only 42 ballots being cast. 25 of these being republicans, 14 democrats, 2 socialists and 1 progressive.

For U. S. senator, Gronna won over his opponents, Worst being second.

Young received a big majority over Tuttle.

Hanna and Burdick ran close, with the former in the lead.

Kraabel received a majority over his opponents.

Berg was high man over the others.

Linde, for attorney general, was high man.

Holbein received the high vote for commissioner of agriculture and labor.

For railroad commissioners, Anderson and Collins were tied with 14 apiece, and Mann and Stutsman 12 each.

For sheriff, Markuson lead over Wallin by 20 to 1.

On the democratic ticket for senator, Jones was high over Purcell.

Knudson was nearly blanked for governor, Hellstrom receiving all but one vote.

Monson, for sheriff, was given all the votes.

For superintendent of schools, Kampen received 24 and Mrs. Brudwick 16.

On the judiciary ticket, Spalding has 22 and Christianson 18.

The vote all over the county was light.
