SILO GROWING IN POPULARITY

There is no Waste and the Results
are Better Where Silos
Are Used.

The building of silos is being carried on by farmers of this and adjoining counties to a greater extent than ever before, and it is probable that every farm in the northern part of the state will be equipped with one, according to the opinion of farm experts and progressive farmers.

Dairy Commissioner R. F. Flint has just received a letter from Howard Willson of Leal, in Barnes county, in which Mr. Willson gives the experience of himself and four neighbors, Andrew Crist, Leal; Lewis Wolf, Wimbledon; John Kuhlman, Jr., Leal; and John Crist, Wimbledon, in co-operative building of silos.

The gentlemen bought their material all at the same time, and there was quite a saving in the amount, one item alone being 40 cents saved on each barrel of cement. There was a proportionate saving in the lumber; nails, wire and other materials that enter into the construction of a concrete silo. Two sets of forms were used and two silos built at one time, butting up one form on each silo every day, and in this manner it required just eleven days to complete the work on two silos, using five men for the work.

The cost of the silos ran from \$227.04 to \$255.57, the difference in the cost being accounted for by there being more delay in some than others, thus making it necessary to use the men a longer time.

Another way in which these five gentlemen have co-operated is in the purchase and use of a cutting machine, all of them using the same
