

Sutton Reporter: The proposition to form a special school district of Mabel and the south third of Kingsley carried by an even two to one vote, Tuesday. Fourteen votes were cast in south Kingsley, all being favorable. In Mabel there were 62 for and 38 against. As the vote in the entire proposed special district is counted together it gives a grand total of 76 for and 38 against or a majority as stated above. The county superintendent will now call an election to elect a school board which will be composed of five members. When these are elected and qualified the question of a suitable building and a location for the same must be submitted to the voters.
