

OUND OVER TO DISTRICT COURT

**O'Shea is in Durance Vile as
a Result of the Fracas in
Blacksmith Shop.**

On a warrant preferred by
Martin Nelson, Pat O'Shea,
charged with assault and battery
with a dangerous weapon, was
arrested last week by State's At-
torney Tutte, and brought be-
fore Justice Larson, on Saturday
last week, for a hearing. Af-

ter the taking of testimony he
was placed under \$800 bonds.
Failing to secure bondsmen he
will enjoy the hospitality of Sher-
iff Lee, awaiting the disposition
of his case when district court
convenes.

This case is the outcome of the
fracas in the blacksmith shop, a
week ago last Saturday evening,
when Nelson was cut in the neck
by a knife in the hands of O'Shea.

Nelson was also arrested on a
charge of maintaining a public
nuisance, but was able to secure
bail.

The hearing Saturday was wit-
nessed by a great many interest-
ed spectators.
