

Sentinel: Dr J. A. H. Winsloe, veterinary surgeon, went out to Mr. Aug. Steinborn's farm Tuesday evening on professional business and up to the time of going to press he had not returned and no word had been received of him other than that he and the driver of the team, T. Cardin, employed in Mason Knapp's livery business, had left the Steinborn farm at half past ten or twenty minutes to eleven Tuesday evening to return to town. At that time the storm had not started, but shortly after eleven the worst storm of the winter reached this section of the state, and, while it is not believed that they have suffered any great mishap, some fear has been expressed.
