

Griggs County Play Day.

The Griggs County Third Annual Play Day will be held at Cooperstown, June 2. The parade will again be an important feature.

The business men from all the towns are invited to take part in the parade in some representative manner. A competitive ball game between the four graded schools of the county will be played as stated on the program. The Griggs County eighth grade exercises will be held on the evening of Play Day, at 8 o'clock, between 30 or 40 eighth grade pupils to receive diplomas. Music will be furnished by the Hannaford and Cooperstown Glee clubs, and the Cooperstown High School orchestra. At the close of the program the prizes, badges and medals will be presented to the winners of the days' events.

The Camp Fire Girls will furnish a part of the room in this building for a mothers' rest room, and mothers with small children and anyone else who desire are invited to make this a rest room.
