

FIRST SELECTED MEN OFF FOR CAMP TODAY

Five Per Cent of Griggs County Quota Reported at Cooperstown
This Morning--Will Leave on Afternoon Train for Camp
Dodge--District Board Not Thru With Exemptions.

The members of the Griggs county draft board have selected the men named above as the first five per cent of the quota from the county.

These men reported to County Auditor Rearick this morning at nine o'clock for roll call, and will leave on today's train for Camp Dodge, the concentration point.

The official call to the county auditor for the first five per cent, from Governor Frazier read as follows:

"Be prepared to send four men to Camp Dodge, Des Moines, Sept. 6.

Routing instructions follow by mail. Make sure that your agent is supplied with through tickets to Camp Dodge."

The next call for 40 per cent will be made Sept. 18, the third call of 40 per cent on Oct. 3, and the remainder will leave as soon as practicable.

The district board has not taken final action on the exemption claims filed by the Griggs county men. 41 names have certified to the local board but some of these will be given another hearing.
