

## Play Day at Cooperstown.

Featured by a large parade, folk dances and all other popular sports, the program given last Saturday at Cooperstown in observance of Griggs County Play day, was quite an event and was attended by hundreds of people.

Every section of the county was well represented, and all forenoon autos and teams brought men, women and children, dressed in gala attire, to spend the day.

A few showers of rain during the day somewhat dampened festivities but most of the program was carried thru. The parade was formed at about 11 o'clock, headed by the Cooperstown band. Nearly every village in the county and many country schools were represented.

In the rural school class the Retzlaff school won first, Houghton second and the Bridge school third. Binford received \$20 in cash as their prize.

At noon the family picnic was held, each visitor bringing a lunch, and coffee was served at the Jimerson building.

The folk dances and Maypole dance given by the lower grades of the Cooperstown school were cleverly executed and were very interesting.
