Sherbrooke, N. D., Nov. 30, 1896.

Meeting of board of county commissioners called at 10 o'clock a. m. Present Commissioner O. W. Williams. There being no quorum present the meeting adjourned until 2 o'clock p. m.

Board reconvened at 2 o'clock p. m. Present, Chairman Rindy, and Commissioners Williams, Brown and King.
