**AFTERNOON SESSION.**

[Continued from last week.]

Sherbrooke, N. D., Jan. 4, 1890.

On motion county auditor was authorized and directed to issue salary warrants on the first day of each and every month for the following county officers, viz: Clerk of court, county judge, states attorney, superintendent of schools and auditor, for one-twelfth of the amount due each of said officers for annual salary as provided by statute.

In accordance with section 2080 of the revised codes of 1895, the county treasurer's salary for the year 1890, was estimated at \$1,380.00, and the county auditor was, on motion, instructed to issue a warrant to said treasurer at the end of each month, up to Jan. 1, 1890, for one-twelfth of said amount.

On motion the county auditor was directed to issue monthly salary warrants to the register of deeds as provided by sections 2075 and 2077, of the revised codes of 1895.

On motion the clerk hire of the register of deeds for the year 1890, was fixed at \$400.00.

On motion the clerk hire of the county treasurer was fixed at the sum of \$150.00 for the year 1890.

On motion the clerk hire of the county auditor was fixed at the sum of \$250.00, for the year 1890.

On motion the balance of \$8.55 in the special salary fund was directed to be placed to the credit of the general fund.

On motion the county auditor was directed to advertise for bids for the

furnishing of material, hauling the same and building the following bridges and additions to bridges, built in 1898, viz:

No. 1. A 40-foot pile bridge between sections 26 and 31, Westfield township.

No. 2. A 12-foot span addition to bridge between sections 6, Primrose township, and section 1, Sherbrooke township.

No. 3. A 12-foot span addition to bridge between sections 31 and 32, Norway township.

Said bids to be opened March 6, 1890, at 2 o'clock p. m.

On motion the monthly reports of fees of the register of deeds for the fourth quarter of 1898, were approved.

On motion the monthly reports of fees by the clerk of the district court for the fourth quarter of 1898, were approved.

On motion the following bills for the salary of county officers for the quarter ending Dec. 31, 1898, on which warrants have heretofore been drawn, were approved as follows, viz:
