

A. L. PLUMMER DEAD.

Col. A. L. Plummer, an old resident of Hillsboro, passed away suddenly at 9 o'clock yesterday morning from an attack of acute indigestion. About 5 o'clock Friday evening he suffered from an attack and was very ill for some hours, but was much better towards morning. At the usual hour yesterday morning he arose and about 9 o'clock was sitting in a chair. Mrs. Plummer heard him cry out and ran into the room where her husband had just expired. It is supposed that he had another attack of indigestion and his heart was paralyzed.

At the time of his death Mr. Plummer was mayor of Hillsboro and always took an active part in municipal affairs. He was also president of the Hillsboro National Bank and owned a large amount of property in many parts of North Dakota.—Fargo Call.
