

DIED.

Chas. Rowe died last Monday evening after an illness of several weeks. His death was caused by pyaemia or blood poisoning following typhoid fever. The funeral was held at the Cong'l church, Rev. Gilpatrick conducting the service. Mr. Rowe was one of the early settlers in Hope. He came to North Dakota in 1881 and to Hope in 1883. Since coming here he has resided in and about Hope nearly all the time. The deceased was about forty years of age. His father, five sisters and four brothers survive him. One brother and one sister live in Hope. Services at the grave were conducted by the Hope I. O. O. F. of which Mr. Rowe was a member. Friends extend sympathy to the family.
