Andrew Kainz, separator man for the Eckels threshing rig, suffered a terrible accident Wednesday afternoon. The wind had blown the cover from the cylinder and straw had covered the opening and it was impossible to see the condition of things. In walking over the machine while at his work he stepped into the cylinder. One of his limbs was so terribly torn and lacerated that it was found necessary to amputate it between the knee and the ankle. The injured man is now at the Hope Hospital and this morning was resting as easily as could be expected, altho he had suffered greatly during the night.
