

Passenger In Ditch

**Last Night's Passenger Wrecked
One Mile North of Page**

**Cars All Overturned in Ditch.
B. T. Kraabel Injured.**

The G. N. Passenger which is due here at 9:19 p. m. was wrecked one mile north of Page at 9 o'clock. last night. The entire train, excepting the engine, was ditched. The engine was derailed but was not overturned. No one was injured to any great extent excepting B. T. Kraabel, of this city, who had his back injured quite severely.

The smashup was caused by a broken rail and it was miraculous that no one was killed.

As the wreck occurred near train time, the waiting room of the depot in this city was packed with waiting passengers and others who were expecting friends, who were considerably excited when the message came telling of the accident. Much relief was expressed when a later telegram announced the details.

Mr. Kraabel was brought home during the night by team, and altho his injuries are painful, it is hoped nothing serious will result from the severe shaking up.

The wrecking train was called out at once and the track was cleared sufficiently this morning to allow other trains to pass. The mails arrived about twelve hours late.
