

Geo Murray Appointed

George Murray, of this county, has been selected by Governor Burke to fill the newly created office of Temperance Commissioner. The new law carries with it an emergency clause so that it is in full force and effect now.

The appointment is made under the provision of S. B. 110, providing for an enforcement commissioner at a salary of \$2,000.00 a year and clerk hire not to exceed \$1,200.00. Mr. Murray's being an attorney, together with his years of active field work under the auspices of the State Enforcement League makes him fully qualified for the position.

The bill carries with it an appropriation of \$8,000.00 to carry on the work.

With George Murray, as Temperance Commissioner the violators of the prohibition law, of high or low degree, had better look a little out—for George Murray has the reputation of doing things. And what he does, along the line of enforcing the prohibition law, he does well.
