

A Bad Fire

The granary and barn on the old Frank Ray farm ten miles northeast of this place, together with 1400 bushels of wheat and 2000 bushels of oats, were destroyed by fire last Sunday afternoon. The fire originated in some straw piles on the adjoining farm. There was no one at the farm at the time, consequently nothing was saved. Mr. and Mrs. Ray and family are living on the old A.S. Mooté place, they having lost their home by fire early this spring. It is certainly big loss. He had not marketed a bushel of this year's crop.
