

OBITUARY.

At her home in Colgate, North Dakota, on March 10th. 1908, after an illness of two weeks, Jane Nesbitt, wife of Andrew Nesbitt in the seventy-second year of her age, entered into her well earned rest.

Born in Norway, she came to U. S. A. at the age of sixteen and settled in Wisconsin, from there she removed to Minnesota, still later removing to Colgate, N. D., where she resided during the past thirteen years.

Of her immediate family of seven, five survive, two sons, James Nesbit, Virgis, Minn.; William Nesbit, Alexander, Minn. and three daughters, Mrs. Russell, Eagle Lake, Minn., Mrs. H. M. Secord, Grand Forks, N. D., Mrs. David Pendergast, Aconda, Montana.

Her life was marked by patience, loving devotion and unselfishness. In her declining years she found great comfort in the scriptures and especially in the psalms of David.

The funeral services were read at the house on March 12th by Rev. F. S. Eastman, of Colgate. The remains were then taken to Grand Forks, to be buried beside her deceased daughter.
