After considering the matter, a motion was made seconded and carried, that the county build a 36 foot wood pile bridge on line between secs. 25 and 36 Primrose, and that the auditor notify the Fargo Bridge & Iron Co. to construct said bridge as per contract with said firm.

Notice having been received from the Board of Supervisors of Broadlawn twp. that the grading, up to Elm river, on line between sections 12 and 13. had been completed, the Chairman on motion appointed F. Gray, J. B. Oxtan and K. S. Sulland to inspect site and take measurments for new bridge to be built at said location.
